

## CONTRIBUTIONS POLICY – 2010

All Association contributions shall be made under one of the following categories:

- A. Professional:** Contributions to organizations for the purpose of improving law enforcement will not exceed \$2500. The amount shall be determined on a case-by-case basis by the Board.
- B. Hospitality Rooms:** Activities organized for the purpose of entertaining Association members with the provision of food and beverage. The maximum contribution shall be \$4000.
- C. Youth Activities:** Contributions to activities organized for the benefit of young people such as Scouts or athletic teams. **The maximum annual contribution shall not exceed \$5000; \$1200 quarterly; and \$400 per applicant.** Applicants will fill out an Association contribution request form and submit it to the Association office or Administrative Secretary. Before the next meeting the Secretary shall review the completed form and copies will be made available to Board members at the beginning of the Board meeting for review.
- D. Retirees:** The LVPOA shall provide an honorarium to any Association member who terminates service or who retires from employment with the Department of Detention & Enforcement with 10 years of service or more. **The honorarium shall not exceed \$500.**

The honorarium shall not be paid to an employee terminated for just cause.
- E. Bereavement:** For the death of an Association member's spouse, parent, or child, the maximum contribution towards floral arrangements shall be \$200. Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed and discussed by the Board.
- F. Political:** All political contributions will be made in accordance with the rules established by the Nevada Revised Statutes.
- G. All Others:** All other contributions will be determined by the Board through a meet and confer.
